- During the workshop please send your written question via chat option. Then questions will be elaborated by our team and then presented to panellist and speakers during the session as PP slide. Please point out for whom a question is addressed or declare it as a general one. Then we can try to address it to the most relevant panellist or speaker.
- All answers will be provided during time planned for discussion, no time for answers is planned directly after presentation.
- Questions not answered during the workshop (if any) will be recorded and we do our best to provide you with the written answer later directly or via Alliance web page. You will be informed.
- If you expected to have short oral contribution, please let us know in advance, giving the subject to be raised and suggested form and time needed.
