



The European Radioecology Alliance (ALLIANCE) was founded in 2009 by eight European organisations strongly involved in radiation protection. At the beginning, the ALLIANCE, together with the EC-STAR Network of Excellence, developed the Strategic Research Agenda (SRA), which defines a long-term vision on the needs and implementation of research in radioecology. The SRA aims are to be useful for science and society, shared by stakeholders and researchers and realistic from an operational and scientific point of view.

Today the ALLIANCE consists of 32 members coming from 16 countries and bring together parts of their respective research and development programmes into the integrated programme that maintains and enhances radioecological competences, experimental infrastructures and addresses scientific and educational challenges in assessing the impact of radioactive substances on humans and the environment.

ALLIANCE as a Research Platform is member of the Consortium MEENAS, integrated by the six European Research Platforms strongly influencing research priorities in European radiation protection (MELODI, EURADOS, EURAMED, NERIS, ALLIANCE and SHARE) and actively contributes to recent EURATOM research projects as e.g. CONCERT and PIANOFORTE.
